

Guide to Applying for a New World Sailing Sailor ID

A **World Sailing Sailor ID** is a unique identifier that allows sailors to compete in international events and be included in World Sailing's ranking systems. It is free to obtain and an essential requirement for many events, including Para and Inclusive Sailing competitions.

Step-by-Step Guide to Applying for a Sailor ID

Step 1: Visit the World Sailing Website

1. Go to the **World Sailing website**: <https://www.sailing.org/>
2. Navigate to the **Sailors** section and select **World Sailing Sailor ID** or use this direct link: [World Sailing Sailor Profile](#).

Step 2: Create an Account

1. If you already have an account, log in using your credentials.
2. If you are new, click on **“Create an Account”** and enter the required details, including:
 - Full name
 - Date of birth
 - Nationality
 - Email address
 - Contact details

Step 3: Complete the Sailor ID Application

1. Once logged in, navigate to **“Apply for a Sailor ID”** under your profile.
2. Fill out the application form with:
 - Your full name as it appears in official documents
 - Your country of representation (usually your National Sailing Federation)

- Your preferred sailing discipline (e.g., Para, Inclusive, Offshore, Dinghy, etc.)
3. Submit your application.

Step 4: Confirmation & Activation

1. After submitting your details, you should receive a **confirmation email** from World Sailing.
2. Your **Sailor ID will be generated and assigned** to you. It may take a few days for processing.
3. Log back into your account to check your **Sailor ID number**, which will be displayed on your profile.

Step 5: Use Your Sailor ID

- Your Sailor ID will be required when registering for World Sailing-sanctioned events.
- If you are competing in **Para Inclusive Sailing events**, ensure that your ID is linked to your classification status (if applicable).

- If you do not receive confirmation within a few days, check your spam/junk email folder.
- If you experience issues, contact **World Sailing Support** or reach out to your **National Sailing Federation** for assistance.
